Section	Minutes
1. Exit Survey & SVR Teams space	Promotion of the SVR Exit Survey and the online SVR Teams space, with links to complete/join.
2. HISA Updates	<p>Amber Kenny (AK) gave some HISA updates, including the HISA election results, Articles & Schedules referendum results, and NUS referendum result. The SVR Impact competition was promoted, as were two surveys for HISA’s current subject interns. The Moray Board of Management and HISA trustee vacancies were promoted.</p> <p>AK gave students Moray-specific updates on progress being made as a result of previous SVR feedback. This included progress on social spaces in Linkwood, catering in Moray Street & linkwood, the AyePod refresh, pool tables, wheelchair access, and the print top-up system.</p>
3. Feedback on March’s SLE theme (Guidance & Support).	AK gave a quick update on what’s been done with feedback from March’s theme. Feedback has been shared with UHI and will feed into HISA’s work on Transformation.

<p>4. SLE theme: Resources, Assessment & Curriculum.</p>	<p>SVRs contributed to our discussion about our SLE theme. Key points included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students wanting lecturers or supervised study sessions right up until exam time, rather than having a gap between lessons ending and exams. • Mixed feedback on the value of spending lots of time on detailed session plans. • Some confusion about who to contact for work placements. • Students would like the library to be open over holiday periods and later into the evenings while preparing for exams. <p>Main actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feedback on this month's theme will be compiled across campuses and shared with UHI • The HISA Moray officers will approach various UHI staff over the next few weeks to tackle the local issues raised.
<p>5. Feedback Open Floor</p>	<p>SVRs shared the feedback they've gathered from their classmates since the last meeting. This included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feedback about how HISA and UHI should be promoting events to students (mobile phone notifications preferred) • Detailed feedback about the prices and exact types of food students would like to see from a new catering contractor. • Suggestions for HISA to give new students tours during welcome week next academic session – SVRs are happy to be involved and help give these tours. • Suggestion for HISA to create an online community for incoming students • Request to know which staff at UHI Moray have mental health first aid training. • Request for the table tennis bats and tables to be fixed • Appreciation for the goal setting and feedback meetings that some staff held with students.
